

Microneedle Array Patch

Different medicines require various different routes of administration, and many require a hypodermic needle. But this is not an inefficient method of administration (its use requires a medical professional) - plus many patients dislike this form of administration, and with certain patients it is not even an option. Microneedle arrays, usually in the form of a patch, have become one of the leading alternatives.



With different representation in the first instance, the client opposition against this patent in the European Patent Office (“EPO”) did not succeed. A change in representation, once an appeal had been filed, led to development of different attack strategies and the filing of supplementary Grounds of Appeal. The patent was subsequently revoked in its entirety following oral argument.
